Symphony Woods

Columbia Association will hold a Pre-Submission Community Meeting for its proposed project in Symphony Woods on Thursday, June 16, at 7pm in the CA Board Room, 10221 Wincopin Circle.



CA has plans to improve approximately 17 acres of Symphony Woods Park. The plan includes walkways through the park, additional spaces for parking, future activity areas, a future fountain area, and a future café with restroom.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide information to the community regarding the proposed Final Development Plan and to allow adjacent property owners and community residents to ask questions and make comments.

Recycle CFLs



Compact fluorescent light bulbs contain mercury and should not be placed with your regular trash. Instead, consider customer take-back programs at Home Depot (*bulbs, no tubes*), Lowe's (*bulbs, no tubes*), My Organic Market (MOMs) and IKEA. CFLs can also be taken to a Household Hazardous Waste day at the Alpha Ridge Landfill on Saturdays in April-November, 8am-4pm.

Pet Law



The calls with complaints about irresponsible pet owners have mounted up again. Let it be known... that according to Howard County Animal Control Laws:

- *A domesticated animal must be on a leash and under the control of a responsible person capable of immediate and effective restraint when not on the owner's property;*
- *Owners are responsible for removing pet defecation when off their own property;*
- *Owners are responsible for preventing their dog from barking to the extent that it disturbs neighbors;*
- *Pet owners must remove an accumulation of defecation from their property to prevent annoying odors; Animals must be provided with proper drink, ventilation, shelter, shade, protection from the elements, sanitary conditions , veterinary care and nutritious food in sufficient quantity.*

That should cover the complaints we've received. If you wish to see a particular law enforced, call Animal Control at 410-313-2780.

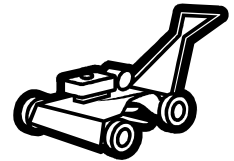
Circle Parking

Any car parked adjacent to the center curb within a cul-de-sac is in violation of Howard County Code 21.221A 18 and may be ticketed by the police. Although parking can be a problem on cul-de-sacs, emergency vehicles must have clear access to all homes on the cul-de-sac. Please comply with this regulation for your own safety as well as for that of your neighbors.

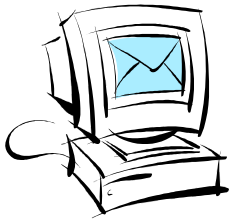


Food Bank
